Background of the Building Project

Clifton Presbyterian Church (CPC) has been a faithful presence for 153 years, sharing its ministry and mission with members and friends. In 2002 members realized the church facility needed improvement to continue meeting our current church and community needs.

Its walls have provided much needed community meeting and educational space. The Clifton Presbyterian Church Preschool operates five days a week, ten months a year and provides a camp for children in the summer. The Boy Scouts, and Alcoholics Anonymous meet weekly. The sanctuary is used for many weddings throughout the year and by New Life Korean Church on Sunday afternoons. Church members prepare lunch in the kitchen for our unhoused neighbors to be served at the Lamb Center. The Fellowship Hall is used for receptions, meetings for HOAs, and other community groups. In addition, Fellowship Hall is a resource to serve our community as a polling place and as a location for a DMV Remote Center.

Our improvement cost \$3.2 million and added 7,600 square feet to the existing building. In 2003 a three-year capital campaign launched “Touching Tomorrow Today,” raising \$1.2 million while the balance was financed. The balance is now at \$500,000 or 16 percent of our original cost. Since 2006 we have diligently reduced the debt and now intend to retire it completely prior to March 2024; the end of our current mortgage term.
