### **Assurance of God's Grace**

One: Hear the Good News! The only one who could judge us calls us friends. Jesus chose us over his own life, so let us choose Jesus in the life we have now. By the power of the Spirit, our sins are washed away, and we are made new.

**All: Let us live as God's forgiven children! Alleluia! Amen.**
